Stevens Company's Drydock on the Twenty-sixth of April 1917,
found shell plates B-1 Starboard and shell plates A-6 and A-7
Starboard to be indented and considerable buckled.

RECOMMEND: - That the plates indented and buckled be
faired in place and that rivetting in way of same be over-
hauled and made good.
