The Second Special Survey No.3 became due 7,30,  
and in view of a general examination made of the vessel at  
Liverpool in November last the Committee agreed to the special  
survey being carried out within the year of grace.

The Boiler Survey became due 2,31. The Screwshaft  
Survey became due 9,30.

The vessel has been laid up since March last.

The Liverpool Surveyors now forward a letter, dated  
the 18th ultimo, from the Owners stating their intention of  
withdrawing the vessel from classification.

The classing Committee had the case before them on  
Friday, 1st instant, when they decided to give instructions  
for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register  
Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating  
withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
