Nature of Survey First entry

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Glasgow Surveyors should be informed that this vessel has proceeded to their port for the purpose of being fitted with her machinery. The engine and boiler casings require to be riveted up after the machinery is fitted, and the Surveyors should be requested to report in form No. 8 when this has been done to their satisfaction, for the information of the Committee, with a view to the classification of the vessel.
