I have to inform you that it appears from a First Entry Report received from the Belfast Surveyors that the S.S. "ONEGA" is proceeding to your port to have her machinery installed, and to complete the survey on the vessel the following work remains to be done, namely:-

Steam steering gear, quadrant, tiller and relieving tackle to be fitted and tested.

Forecastle deck to be hose tested after fitting deck plates over hawsepipes.

Engine and boiler casings to be riveted up.

I shall be glad if you will arrange for these matters to receive attention, and on completion of the survey forward a report on Form 8, with a view to the classification of the vessel.
