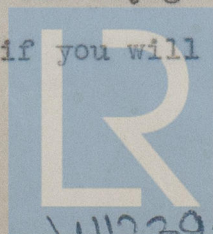
Dear Sirs,

H. I have to acquaint you that the P. & O. Steam Navigation Co., of this City have intimated that they have sold the steamer "BERRIMA" to Japanese Owners for delivery in Japan, and it would appear that the vessel is now on her way to Yokohama.

In the circumstances I think it well to acquaint you that the annual boiler survey which became due so long ago as November 1929 has been partly held and that to complete the survey for a record of B.S. 6,30 all the boilers require to be examined under steam, and their safety valves adjusted, and all mountings and safety valves of the double ended boilers and the starboard single ended boiler (except check valves) of starboard single ended boiler) require to be examined.

It will be observed that the port screwshaft became due for inspection at the end of June last and that the vessel has now become due for 2nd Special Survey No.1

It has been stated that the "BERRIMA" is to be broken up on the completion of the voyage to Japan and in the circumstances I shall be glad if you will make enquiries and
