
With reference to my letter of the 2/4th ultimo respecting your new suction Dredger "MEGOHM", and I now beg to inform you that cablegrams have been received from the Society's Surveyor at Rangoon from which it appears that the Oil Fuel installation is fitted in accordance with the Society's Rules, and that the anchors have been verified with their certificates of test.

The Committee have had the case before them to-day and the vessel has been classed Al Dredger "For River and Harbour Services", and with notations of *LMC 2,28, Fitted for Oil Fuel 2,28, F.P. above 150° F.

In accordance with the usual practice the classification certificates are being forwarded to the Society's Surveyors at Glasgow to be handed to the Builders, and they will no doubt reach your hands in due course.
