Ltd., have the newly installed machinery of the steel single screw suction Dredger "Megohn" examined and tested under steam by a competent Engineer Surveyor, who on completion of examination reports to me that he found everything to his satisfaction.

The safety valves of the Boiler were adjusted under steam in the Surveyor's presence and set to release at a working pressure of 140 lbs. per square inch.

I will therefore report to the Committee of this Society, London, accordingly and will recommend that this vessel's machinery be classed ~~as~~ *Lmc 2-28* in the Register Book.
