Messrs. Fleming & Ferguson Ltd. survey the single screw suction dredger (Yard No. 490) 85' x 24' x 6'-6" moulded, while building at their Works at Paisley on the 19th April 1927 and subsequent dates.

This vessel is for the Burmah Oil Co. Ltd., and has been framed, the keelsons, bulkheads, beams, deck stringers and plating, shell plating, deckhouses, casings and pillars fitted but practically no riveting has been done excepting:- Frame to Beam and Floor Brackets, Bottom Frames and Reverse Frames to Floors, Chocks to Intercostal Plates, Part Boiler Stools.

The Anchors, & Cables, ~~Winches~~ have been supplied.

So far as advanced, the vessel has been constructed to my entire satisfaction and in accordance with plans, and is such as could be approved for the Class &AL "Dredger".
