With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "KAIFUKU MARU", which vessel it is understood has now become your property, I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Kobe have forwarded to this Office a copy of your letter addressed to them on the 23rd ultimo intimating that you do not wish to continue the classification of this vessel with the Society.

The Committee have had the case before them at their meeting to-day, and in all the circumstances they have given instructions for the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
