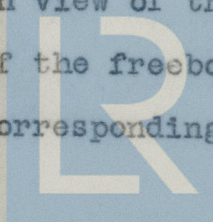
Dear Sirs,

Your letter of the 16th ultimo addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Genoa regarding your steamers "NITRO" and "MILANESE" has been forwarded to this Office and the Committee regret to note therefrom that you have decided for reasons of economy to withdraw the classification of these vessels from this Society.

Whilst it is quite appreciated that present difficult conditions have caused you to take this action, the Committee trust they will have the pleasure of other business relationships with you when times improve.

The cases of both the vessels have been under the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today, and in the circumstances they have given instructions for the vessels' classes to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof in each case, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of these vessels' classes the records of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draughts, will also
