Survey

The class is subject to indented bottom plating etc. being dealt with at the Owners' convenience.

The 2nd S.S. No.3, due 9.30, has been partly held and a proposal to complete same by 8th January 1932, has been agreed to.

Repairs are required to shell plating etc.

The Fremantle Surveyor now reports the vessel to have lost a bower anchor and sixty fathoms of chain cable.

The Surveyor recommends the equipment be placed in order at the earliest opportunity.

The year of grace expired 9.31.

It is submitted action be deferred.
