
The Second Special Survey No.2 became due on this ship 9,29. The Boiler Survey became due 1,31.

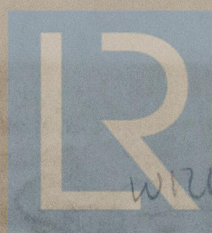
In December, 1929, the Committee agreed to a proposal of the Owners to carry out the Special Survey on the vessel's arrival ^{at Rotterdam} in about three months from that time.

The vessel arrived at Rotterdam on the 20th August last where she was laid up, and on the expiration of the year of grace the usual undertaking was furnished by the Owners.

On the 6th instant the Rotterdam Surveyors reported that the vessel had been sold to Messrs. N. V. Frank Rijdsdijk's Industrieele Ondernemingen, at Hendrik-Ido-Ambacht, in order to be broken up.

The case was under the consideration of the Classing Committee on Tuesday, 17th instant, when in all the circumstances it was decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line (3,31), indicating non-compliance with the Rules.
