In December 1929 the Committee agreed to a proposal of the Owners to have the 2nd Special Survey No.2 held on the vessel's arrival at Rotterdam in about three months time.

The Rotterdam ^{Surveyors} stated in September last that the vessel was laid up and the Owners furnished the usual undertaking on the 6th October.

The Rotterdam Surveyors now write they have been informed by the Owners that the vessel has been sold to Messrs. N.V. Frank Rijdsdijk's Industrieele Ondernemingen at Hendrik-Ido-Ambacht, in order to be broken up.
