Fresh water line above centre of disc 6 1/2 ins.

Indian Summer line above centre of disc 6 ins.

Winter line below centre of disc 6 ins.

Winter North Atlantic line below centre of disc - ins.

Distance between the top of statutory deck line on vessel's side and the intersection of the continuation of upper side of wood or iron deck with the vessel's side { at main, spar or upper dk. 2 ins.

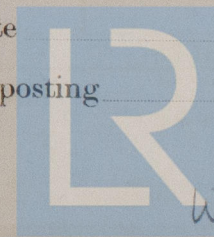
