Mr. Leeuwenburg has requested statistics regarding the number of vessels of the shelter deck type without tonnage opening which have been reported foundered, abandoned or missing during certain periods, also similar statistics regarding the full scantling type. He further requests to know what percentage of the vessels of the mercantile fleet are of the closed shelter deck type.

A list of steamers and motorships abandoned, foundered and missing during the years <sup>1919-</sup>1925 which at the time of their loss held the class 100A1 "Shelter deck with freeboard" has been compiled and is attached herewith. Further a list of the steamers abandoned, foundered and missing during the periods mentioned by Mr. Leeuwenburg is also attached, together with a list of ships holding different classes in the Society's Register Book in 1925/6, and a list of classed vessels abandoned during the year 1925 - 1926 has also been got out.

Mr. Leeuwenburg might be informed that the exact percentage of vessels in the mercantile fleet of the closed shelter deck type is not known.
