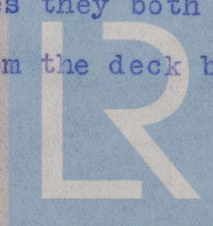

erections. No T.O.

From the above examination of losses of this type
of vessel, viz: - "Shelter deck with freeboard", it is to be noted two cases
are British -- at the time of their losses they both had tonnage openings
and their freeboard would be assigned from the deck below the shelter deck.
