

Translation of my letter as published in the "TELEGRAAF"
morning paper of the 20th instant.

OUR SHIPPING INSPECTION;

"Mr. R. Leeuwenburg, Principal Surveyor to Lloyd's
Register of Shipping, writes us as follows:

In your evening paper of the 13th instant I have
found under the heading "Our Shipping Inspection" an
article which I have read with great surprise. Who has
sent you this article or by whom you were furnished
with particulars is entirely unknown to me, but I have
considered it to the interest of the whole community
to point out to you that he, who has given you this
information does not appear to be conversant with the
position and the working of the Classification Society's
specially in this case with that of Lloyd's Register
of Shipping and the position it holds towards the Dutch
Scheepvaart Inspection. I have further considered it
necessary to let you know that the steamer "ANDLK" has
always fully complied with Lloyd's Register's requirements
, which is still the case and that a certificate of class
will be granted upon the issue of which, a certificate
of the Dutch Scheepvaart Inspection follows."
