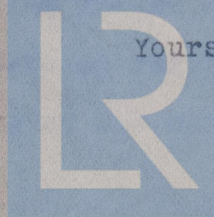

At the same time the Chairman will be glad if you will obtain as full and complete a report as is available of the lawsuit which appears to have been raised in the courts in connexion with damage to the "ANDIJK" on her recent voyage across the Atlantic.
