The class of this vessel was expunged with a red line in December 1931.

A letter has now been received from the Owners stating that their agent at Newcastle was mistaken in saying that they did not wish to continue the vessel's class with this Society, and that they informed the Captain about a fortnight ago that he was to call in the Society's Surveyors for the purpose of holding the boiler survey and examining the hull, and they regret that this was not done. They state that the vessel is at present at Havre, and they desire the Society's Surveyor at that port to make the necessary general examination of the hull, but they wish to defer the boiler survey until the first convenient opportunity, when the boilers will be accessible for this purpose.

A letter has also been received from the Bergen Surveyor stating that 4000 tons of cargo have so far been loaded, and that the ship is to be sold in China.

As it will be impossible to make a general examination of this vessel with cargo on board, and as the Owners apparently do not wish to carry out the boiler survey now, it is submitted they be informed that the class of the vessel cannot be re-instated.
