I accordingly telegraphed to you this afternoon as follows, viz:-

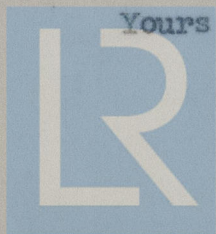
"VALHALL CLASS EXPUNGED WITH RED LINE INFORM
