I have to acknowledge the receipt of your telegram, as below, in regard to the steamer "VALHALL", and to confirm the telephonic conversation which has taken place between us today respecting this vessel.

The case has received the consideration of the Committee, and in confirmation of my telegram, as under, I have to say that the Boiler Survey must be carried out and the vessel generally examined and favourably reported upon before she proceeds to sea, otherwise the class will be dealt with. You will be so good as to notify me immediately by telegram should the vessel leave your district without the above requirements being carried out.

I may add that I am telegraphing to the Society's Surveyor at Bergen requesting him to inform the Owner to the above effect.

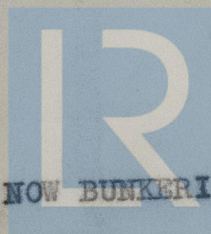
