Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd instant respecting the cases of the steamers "CAMBRIAN PEERESS" and "CAMBRIAN DUCHESS" and to say that the same was read to the Committee at their meeting today.

In the circumstances of the case I have to say that the Committee will raise no objection to the vessels proceeding from Antwerp to the Tyne, where it is noted they are to be offered for sale, and to allow the Boiler Surveys to be postponed until their arrival in the latter district, subject to the boilers being examined under steam and being found satisfactory by the Society's Surveyors at Antwerp before the vessels leave that port.

I am advising the Surveyors to this effect and shall be glad if you will make arrangements accordingly.
