On the 3rd November the Receiver and Manager wrote:

"The steamer "CAMBRIAN DUCHESS" is still under arrest by creditors in Antwerp Docks and I hope it can be arranged for the special survey of the Boilers to be postponed for the present"

and in the circumstances the Committee deferred consideration of the case for a time.

A letter has now come to hand, however, from the Receiver and Manager in reply to an enquiry in regard to the Boiler survey, reading as follows:

The "CAMBRIAN DUCHESS" is still under arrest in Antwerp Docks I am hoping, however, that I shall be able to complete arrangements with the Creditors so that the vessel may be released and transferred to an English Port in the near future when I shall take immediate steps to sell her"
