

The Boiler Survey of this vessel became due 8,31.

A letter is now to hand from the Owners stating that they have decided to allow the vessel to fall out of classification.

A letter has also been received from the Grimsby Surveyors from which it appears that they have interviewed the Owners' local Steamship Manager on the subject, who informed them that as they had not succeeded in their efforts to sell the vessel he expected she would be eventually broken up, and for this reason they did not wish to continue the class.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, 9th instant, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
