With reference to your letter of the 9th. instant, enclosing one from Mr McKeand, submitting for the consideration of the Committee an amended plan of the donkey boiler, No. 2046, to be built by Mr John Cochrane for Messrs Cammell Laird & Co's S.S. No. 670, I have to acquaint you in regard thereto that the amended joint of the lower part of the shell will be approved of provided the tensile strength of the shell plate be not greater than 30 tons per square inch, and the shell plate be annealed after being welded.

If, therefore, this condition is complied with, and the boiler be built in accordance with the plan now submitted, under the usual conditions of survey and testing and to the entire satisfaction of the local Engineer Surveyor, the same will be approved by the Committee for the intended working pressure of 100 lbs per square inch.

The plan referred to is returned herewith. The original plan, sent for reference, has been cancelled and retained here.
