TO CARRY OUT COMPLETE SURVEY LETTER FOLLOWING".


I telephoned the Dartmouth Coaling Co. again this morning respecting the survey being carried out and they informed me that as far as they were aware the British Corporation Surveyor was carrying out a survey on this vessel so as to enable her to load a cargo of coal and proceed to Italy for breaking up purposes, but they advised getting in touch with Mr. Parsons, the British Corporation Surveyor who could inform me exactly what was being done as telegrams had been received from the new Owners in Italy calling him in to carry out the survey.

I telephoned Mr. Parsons house at Bickleigh and the lady answering the phone informed me that Mr. Parsons had gone to Dartmouth to carry out a survey on the "MAGELLAN" and that he intended telegraphing London this evening if everything was satisfactory
