With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "MAGELLAN", which vessel it is understood is now your property, I have to inform you that this vessel's class has been allowed to remain in the Register Book up to the present, whilst she has been laid up, on the understanding that the overdue Special Survey No.1 would be carried out before she went to sea.

It is understood from information which has been received from the Society's Surveyor at Plymouth that it is your intention to take the vessel to Italy to be broken up, and that you have not requested any survey to be held by the Society's Surveyor.

In the circumstances the case has been reported to the General Committee at their meeting to-day, and they have decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
