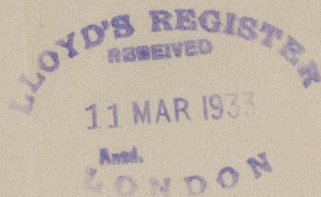

"MAGELLAN".

Yours of 8th inst. to hand with reference to the
Boilers of above vessel, laid up at Dartmouth.

For your information, I would mention that these
Boilers are under the constant care and daily inspection of
the Chief Engineer, who has been retained on board for that
purpose.

One of the Boilers is completely filled with
water. The remainder are empty, dried out, and lime pans
maintained at suitable positions within each of the Boilers,
to avoid collection of any moisture, the lime being changed
regularly as necessary. A weekly report is rendered to
this Office on the matter. Steam has not been raised,
and there is no intention to do so during the period of
lay up.

In the event of any change in the position,
which would necessitate the raising of steam, you will be
advised, and we trust that the special provisions taken,
as above, for the care of these Boilers in the meantime,
will be satisfactory to your requirements.
