Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "NIKOLINA MATKOVIC" and to the Second Special Survey No.3 which became due on this vessel in July, 1932, but has not yet been completed, I have to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a communication from the Society's Surveyor at Split forwarding letters which he has received from you intimating that you do not desire to continue this vessel's classification with this Society.

The Committee have had the case before them at their meeting today, and with regard thereto I am directed to point out that the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of a Special Survey expired in this case at the end of July last, and that on the 14th of that month the Committee agreed to an extension of the vessel's class until her return to Split about the first week in August, on the distinct understanding that the Special Survey would be completed and Boiler Survey held then without fail.

In view, however, of the intimation now received from you the Committee have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance
