Dear Sirs,

A. With reference to your letter of the 16th ultimo respecting the fees to be charged for the Classification and Damage Surveys on the steamer "MOGADOR", your report No. 73308, I have to inform you in reply to your enquiry that your proposal that an inclusive fee of £105 (one hundred guineas) should be charged on the hull and machinery in this instance, in addition to the £4. 4. 0 for freeboard assignment, has been agreed to, and you will, therefore, be good enough to render your accounts accordingly.

Of the fee of £105 above referred to, two-thirds should be considered as the fee for the hull, and one-third for the machinery.
