

The First Special Survey No.1 became due on this vessel in August, 1932, and a proposal to postpone the same until last month was agreed to.

The Kobe Surveyors now forward a translation of a letter from the Owners intimating that they wish to discontinue the classification of this vessel with this Society.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, 11th instant, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

It may be mentioned that these Owners have three other vessels, and the Kobe Surveyors, in their covering letter, state that they called on the Owners at their Office in Osaka, who informed them that as the remainder of their vessels were classed with the Kaiji Kyokai, it was more convenient for them to have all their vessels under one classification.
