We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, Engines and Boilers of the Vessel No. 448 building by Messrs. Nagasaki works, Mitsubishi Zosen Kaisha for ~~Messrs.~~ G. Yamamoto, Osaka, of about 5600 Tons. Length 405'-0" Breadth 55'-0", Depth 32'-0" intended to be Classed ✠ 10041.4 ✠ LMC.

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
