The Owner of the steamer "SCOTSCRAIG" has received from Messrs. Chas. Barrie & Sons a copy of the letter, dated 8th instant, addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Dundee regarding the survey to be held to enable the vessel to proceed to Rotterdam in tow as a classed ship.

The Owner states he does not understand what ^{is} the meaning of the requirements ~~is~~, and that he is definitely not prepared to incur any expense whatever, as the vessel is to be towed to Rotterdam for breaking up.

It was explained to him that if a certificate was desired it would only be possible to grant the same provided the survey was carried out in accordance with the instructions already given, and if he was not prepared to arrange for the survey he must take the vessel as an unclassed ship.

He then stated that as he was not prepared to arrange for the survey he would do as he thought fit. *in the matter*
