S. With reference to your letter of the 8th instant, respecting the case of the steamer "SCOTSCRAIG", I have to acquaint you that the Owner's Representative states that this vessel has been sold to Rotterdam, to which port she will proceed in tow.

In the circumstances you should carry out the survey in accordance with the instructions contained in my letter of the 4th instant, and if upon examination you find the hull, one boiler, windlass, pumps, steering engine, etc., in a satisfactory condition, you will be at liberty to issue the necessary certificate.
