

It is submitted that a copy of the letter from Mr. A. H. Smith, of this day's date, be forwarded to the Dundee Surveyors for their information.

The Surveyors should be informed that the Main Boilers are to be examined on the fire and water sides, in order that they may satisfy themselves that the boilers are in fit condition for the voyage. The fire bars need not necessarily be removed.

The question of opening mountings is one entirely for the Surveyors' discretion.

As regards the engines, these should be examined generally and, together with the boilers, tested under steam. No opening up is necessary, unless considered to be so by the Surveyors.
