The 2nd S.S.No.1 became due 2,32 and no part of this survey has been held.

Permanent repairs are required to the tank top under boilers, and the engine room tank to be scaled and cement washed and the main boilers cleaned.

The vessel is laid up and the usual undertaking has been furnished.

On 4th instant permission was given for the vessel to be moved to the Forth or the Tyne ^{in tow}, provided the Surveyors satisfied themselves that she was in fit condition to proceed.

A letter has now been received from the Owners requesting that she might be allowed to take a cargo of coal to Italy, on the understanding that she will be broken up on arrival there.

It is submitted the Owners be informed that provided the vessel be generally examined in accordance with Circular No.1605, she could proceed to a coal port in the U.K. or ^{to load} Continent/and thence to Italy to be broken up.
