Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 1st instant, from which I note that you desire to move the s.s. "SCOTSCRAIG", which has been laying up at Dundee, to either the Forth or the Tyne, and that she is likely to proceed under tow to one or other of these destinations.

With regard thereto and in reply to your enquiry I have to inform you that the Committee will raise no objection to the vessel being moved as proposed, provided the Society's Surveyors at Dundee are given an opportunity to satisfy themselves that she is in a fit condition to be moved as desired, and it will be necessary for them to give special attention to the windlass and steering gear.

As you are aware, however, the vessel's class is subject to the donkey boiler not being used, and as the main boiler has not been surveyed since April, 1932, the Surveyors must satisfy themselves as to the condition of the main boiler which will be used on the passage.

I am advising the Society's Surveyors at Dundee of the above decision, and conclude that you will at once get into touch with them, or advise this Office, when it will be
