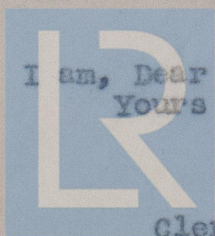
With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "SCOTSCRAIG", I beg to acquaint that the Second Special Survey No.1 became due in February, 1932, but has not yet been held. In addition repairs are required to the tank top under the boilers and the engine room tank requires to be scaled and cement washed and the main boilers cleaned.

The Committee have had the case before them to-day together with a letter from the Dundee Surveyor from which it appears that the vessel is laid up there, and in the circumstances I have to say that the Committee will be agreeable to the vessel's class in the Register Book remaining undisturbed for the present, while she is laid up, subject to the conditions set forth on the enclosed form of undertaking, which I shall be glad if you will kindly sign and return to this Office.
