Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 4th instant returning the deferred reports on the Steamer "SCOTSCRAIG", as requested, and note that nothing whatever has been done since the vessel arrived at your port in regard to the cleaning of the main boilers and the engine room tank.

I may say that these reports were required in view of a request which had been received from Mr. E.J. Leslie for certificates for the Special Survey No.3, which was held in February, 1928, and also for the Boiler Survey, commenced by you in April last and completed at Antwerp in May, to be handed to the Royal Bank of Scotland in connection with the sale of the vessel.
