I am in receipt of your letter of the 8th inst respecting the steamer "SCOTSCRAIG" and note what you write with regard to the position of the vessel when she was at Hong Kong.

As she is due at Liverpool at the end of this month I shall be glad if you will arrange for an opportunity to be afforded the Society's Surveyors to make the necessary inspection of the port main boiler in connexion with the repairs which were effected to the port and starboard furnaces ^{centre} of this boiler at Colombo, otherwise the vessel's class may be jeopardized.
