I beg to state that the Society's Surveyors at Genoa have duly forwarded to this Office a copy of your letter of the 24th ultimo, addressed to them respecting your steamer "DANTE", from which the Committee regret to learn that owing to the present shipping crisis, and to curtail expense, you have decided to withdraw this vessel from the Society's classification.

The Committee have had the case before them at their meeting to-day, and in the circumstances they have given instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

At the same time, the Committee desire me to say that they very much appreciate the kindly sentiments expressed in your letter and trust that they may have the pleasure of again renewing business relationships with your goodselves on the advent of better times.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by
