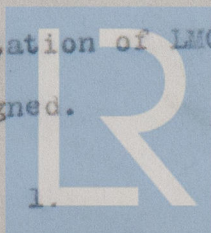

Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 24th ultimo submitting for the consideration of the Committee plans of the main boilers together with particulars of the shafting of the S.S. "ARABIC" ex "BERLIN" built in 1908 under the supervision of the Surveyors to the Germanischer Lloyd, and now under survey at your port with a view to classification with this Society, and with regard thereto I am directed to acquaint you that provided the working parts of the engines be opened out and examined and found in good order and safe working condition and in accordance with the Rules: the boilers be examined throughout and the furnaces be found to shew no sign of strain; their scantlings be in accordance with the plans and the boilers be found in good order and safe working condition; the pumping arrangements be in order and in accordance with the Rules; the machinery will be accepted in this instance for the working pressure of 15.5 kilogrammes per square centimetre (220 pounds per square inch), and a notation of LMC (with date) without the distinguishing mark * assigned.
