Dear Sirs,

S. I duly received your letter of the 18th ultimo, which has crossed mine to you of the same date, respecting the surveys, in accordance with the Society's Rules, which are now overdue on your Tug "HULLMAN", and which are required to be carried out to entitle the vessel to retain her class in the Society's Register Book.

The General Committee have had your letter under consideration at their meeting to-day, and as it would appear that you are not prepared to submit the vessel to the required surveys, they regret that they have no other course to follow than to agree to your suggestion to forego the vessel's classification.

In these circumstances, they have given instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
