Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your memorandum of the 23rd ultimo respecting the survey of the Screw Shaft of the steamer "HULLMAN" and have placed the same before the Committee at their meeting today.

It is noted that the vessel is at present laid up at Quebec for the Winter but that she will be drydocked for the examination of the Screwshaft before the opening of navigation, and I have to say that, in the circumstances, the Committee have deferred consideration of the case for the present on the understanding that the inspection in question is held without fail before she resumes service. I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.

At the same time I have to request that you will advise me immediately should the vessel leave your district without having the requisite survey carried out.
