In May, 1930 the Montreal Surveyor stated that this vessel was laid up at Quebec and that it was the Owners' intention to have the above survey held before she was again employed.

The same Surveyor stated in September last that the outstanding survey would receive attention at the close of the season and in the circumstances the Committee agreed to this proposal.

He now states, however, that the steamer is at present laid up at Quebec for the Winter but that she will be drydocked for the examination of the screwshaft before the opening of navigation
