Dear Sir,

I have to confirm as per attached translations, cablegrams exchanged between us regarding the above vessel.

In my letter of the 27th February last I informed you that this vessel which had been laid up, had been surveyed by the Teikoku Kaiji Kyokai, and proceeded to sea without any part of the Special Survey No.3 being completed, and since receiving your letter of the 11th March we have communicated with the Owners on several occasions in regard to their intention, without receiving any definite reply.

On receipt of your cablegram yesterday we immediately telegraphed again informing them that we required a reply immediately in regard to their

intentions, and as no reply has been received I have
cabled to you today to that effect.

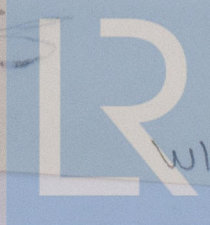
