With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "TELLO", I beg to inform you that a cablegram has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Oslo stating that you did not wish to retain the vessel's class in the Society's Register Book.

The Committee have had the case before them and in all the circumstances and in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed for the completion of the Special Survey No.3 of this vessel expired at the end of June last they regret that they have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

In taking this action they desire me to point out, as has no doubt been explained to you by the Society's Surveyors at Oslo they were prepared to met your wishes to postpone the completion of the survey until the termination of the vessel's present charter, which they have been informed would expire in November/December next provided you would


arrange to place the vessel in dry dock in order that the Society's Surveyors could take the opportunity of making a general examination at an early date and to your completing the machinery survey. As, however, you have not seen your way to comply with this requirement, the Committee have had no alternative, as stated above, but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be dealt with in the manner indicated.
