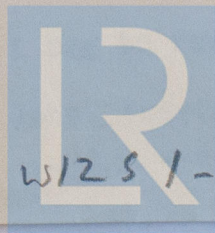
I can not state accurately when the vessel will complete her voyages on Kirkenes, as this for a great part depends on the port of discharge to which the vessel is directed to, but I expect it will be about November this year, That is, a few months over the time will elapse and when such a big economical question for the owners is concerned, I hope that Lloyd's will accept the arrangement mentioned above,
