S. I beg to state that your letter of the 9th ultimo, addressed to the Society's Surveyor at Bombay, respecting the tug "THEYDON", has been duly forwarded to this Office.

The case has been submitted for the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today, and I am directed to acquaint you that, in view of your intimation, instructions have been given for this vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
