We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to inspect & survey during construction the set of $10\frac{1}{2}$ " $14\frac{1}{2}$ " $24\frac{1}{2}$ " by 18" stroke triple Expansion engines building for Messrs. Bruchton's Yard No. 518.

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
